

Driving Directions to Vista Celestial

From San Jose:

The fastest way to get to Uvita from San José is to take Route 27 (Toll Road) towards Orotina, pay attention to the exit to Jaco – Tárcoles, which takes you on Route 34 (Costanera) with a straight shot to Uvita. You will go through the towns of Parrita and Quepos, and continue to Dominical. Once you pass Dominical it is 15 more minutes to Uvita. Total travel time: about 3 hours and 30 minutes. (1 hour on Route 27 and 2.5 hours on Route 34).

How to get to Route 27 from the San Jose, CR airport?

Exit the airport heading NORTH in the direction of Puntarenas and San Ramon (away from San Jose, in the opposite direction) and drive down the Pan-American highway (highway 1). After approximately 4Km, you will see the large Dos Pinos factory on your left. If you see the Dos Pinos you know you are doing well so keep going! Keep driving for 1 more Km until you get to a bridge (also called puente de la Revision Tecnica de alajuela). Do not get on the bridge - just take the first exit on the right immediately after this bridge (There are no signs). Go through the round-about so you cross Highway 1 below and continue on the road which is called Radial El Coyol. Within 5 minutes you will run into a roundabout which will take you onto Route 27 Highway, towards Orotina.





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After you arrive in Uvita. Uvita to Vista Celestial:

- 1. Turn left of the Route 34 Costanera Highway at the Banco de Costa Rica.
- 2. Continue straight for about 1 Km (3/4mile) past a small cemetery on your right.
- 3. Take a left up the hill at the fork of the road below a large Mango Tree with all kinds of hotel signs (ours as well).
- 4. Continue straight, you will see the entrance to the Uvita Waterfall (Catarata de Uvita) on your right.
- 5. Continue and you will cross a small concrete bridge
- 6. Once you pass the concrete bridge you will see a fork in the road and you will continue to the right onto the Rancho Pacifico road. You will see Rancho Pacifico signage and Vista Celestial signage.
- Within a hundred yards you will encounter another concrete bridge. ENGAGE YOUR 4X4 LOW (2ND GEAR WORKS BEST). DON'T SHIFT AFTER YOU CONTINUE UP THE ROAD.
- 8. Stay in 4X4 Low and follow the Rancho Pacifico & Vista Celestial signage for about 2Km (1.3miles). You will see the Vista Celestial road sign just before our entrance made out of black volcano rock and black metal.
